Holy Father, who gathered us here around the table of your Son to share this meal with the whole household of God: in that new world where you reveal the fullness of your peace, gather people of every race and language to share in the eternal banquet of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Romans 9:1-5 I am speaking the truth in Christ, I am not lying; my conscience confirms it by the Holy Spirit, I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart. For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my own people, my kindred according to the flesh. They are Israelites, and to them belong the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the worship, and the promises; to them belong the patriarchs, and from them, according to the flesh, comes the Messiah, who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen..

Matthew 14: 13-21 Now when Jesus heard this, Jesus withdrew from there in a boat to a deserted place by himself. But when the crowds heard it, they followed Jesus on foot from the towns. When Jesus went ashore, Jesus saw a great crowd; and he had compassion for them and cured their sick. When it was evening, the disciples came to Jesus and said, 'This is a deserted place, and the hour is now late; send the crowds away so that they may go into the villages and buy food for themselves.' Jesus said to them, 'They need not go away; you give them something to eat.' They replied, 'We have nothing here but five loaves and two fish.' And Jesus said, 'Bring them here to me.' Then Jesus ordered the crowds to sit down on the grass. Taking the five loaves and the two fish, he looked up to heaven, and blessed and broke the loaves, and gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds. And all ate and were filled; and they took up what was left over of the broken pieces, twelve baskets full. And those who ate were about five thousand men, besides women and children.

Psalms 17: 1-7, 15 Hear a just cause, O Lord; attend to my cry; give ear to my prayer from lips free of deceit. **From you let my vindication come; let your eyes see the right.** If you try my heart, if you visit me by night, if you test me, you will find no wickedness in me; my mouth does not transgress. **As for what others do, by the word of your lips I have avoided the ways of the violent.** My steps have held fast to your paths; my feet have not slipped. **I call upon you, for you will answer me, O God; incline your ear to me, hear my words.** Wondrously show your steadfast love, O saviour of those who seek refuge from their adversaries at your right hand. **As for me, I shall behold your face in righteousness; when I awake I shall be satisfied, beholding your likeness.** Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning is now and shall be forever. Amen.
